Ilowing the recent detection of wild poliovirus in Nigeria, Ministers of Health from Cameroon, Central African public, Chad, Niger and Nigeria have declared the polio outbreak in Nigeria as a public health emergency for untries of the Lake Chad basin. The declaration, coming out of the 66th session of the World Health ganization Regional Committee for the African Region, demonstrates commitment from governments across region to bolster momentum in the fight against the virus.

regional response to a regional risk

e declaration requests that Nigeria and all countries of the Lake Chad Basin, as a matter of the utmost gency, fully implement coordinated outbreak responses in order to quickly interrupt this outbreak before the d of 2016 and prevent international spread. It calls on all Member States of countries of the Lake Chad Basin extend all possible support, including political advocacy and engagement at all levels, for successful ordination and implementation of synchronized polio vaccination activities across the countries of the Lake ad sub-region. The declaration builds on the sustained commitment of member states across the region in the th towards polio eradication, highlighted at the African Union summit in June 2015 where African heads of ite gathered to declare polio eradication a "historical legacy for future generations".

mediate action, challenging terrain

immediate response was mounted by the Nigerian government following the outbreak by quickly declaring it a public health emergency and mobilizing the needed resources, with a large-scale vaccination campaign

plemented and further rounds planned across the Lake Chad sub-region.

nile challenging terrain lies ahead in beating the poliovirus for good, in Nigeria, and in Africa – not least cause of the grave humanitarian situation in many of the countries around Lake Chad – the declaration of a gional emergency provides an important foundation for action, including the mobilization of necessary financial, litical and technical support from partners of the Global Polio Eradication Initiative and governments across the gion.
