Open sources reported 49 health clinics and hospitals damaged or destroyed by explosive weapons between January 2015 and June 2016.

In 2015, open sources reported 20 health clinics and hospitals damaged or destroyed by explosives weapons in 14 incidents. During the first six months of 2016, open sources reported 29 health clinics and hospitals damaged or destroyed by explosives weapons in

20 incidents.
