JULY-SEPTEMBER 2016 FACILITY TRACER MEDICINES STOCK STATUS REPORT

A Publication of the Ministry of Health Uganda

The quarterly report on the facility stock status of the 41 tracer items (in different baskets) provides information about the stock situation of health facilities in the country in order to inform the Ministry of Health and all stakeholders to make appropriate logistics decisions that ensure an effective health commodities supply chain. The report shows the number and percentages of facilities that are appropriately stocked, over stocked or under stocked by level of care and ownership based on Months of Stock (MOS). The MOS highlights the number of months a product will last based on the present consumption rate. It also further indicates facilities that have over 8 months of stock (MOS) broken down by level of care and ownership. The report shows the availability of the different baskets and overall using two indicators i.e. 1) Average percentage availability of a basket of 41 commodities based on all reporting facilities in the previous quarter Definition : Availability is measured as the number of days for which a specific commodity was in stock at the facility store during the reporting period.

2) Percentage of facilities that had over 95% availability of a basket of commodities in the previous quarter

Definition : This indicator measures the % of health facilities that reported having the basket of commodities available during the reporting period.

KEY FINDINGS

1. Overall, facility reporting rates increased to 63% (3909 / 6229) from 60% (3735 / 6187) in the previous quarter

2. Overall average percentage availability for the basket of 41 commodities was 83% and percentage of facilities with over 95% availability was 54%

3. Percentage of facilities with over 95% was highest for TB medicines at 60% (1181 / 1574) and available for the least number of days at the health facility store 75% (68 / 90 days)

4. High percentage of facilities were either understocked/stocked out or overstocked

5. HC3s and HC4s make the largest percentage of overstocked facilities

6. All EMHS commodities experienced a stock out during the quarter

7. A number of facilities have commodities not for their LOC

On average the basket of 41 commodities was available 83% of the time (75/90 days): down from 89% in the last quarter
On average 54% of health facilities reported over 95% availability of the basket of commodities

3. For the EMHS basket, availability was lowest for Therapeutic milk F75 (15%), Therapeutic milk F100 (17%), insulin (25%), cardiac aspirin (27%) and captopril (37%). Captopril was similarly stocked out at central level. NMS is not supplying Nutritional food supplements to health facilities explaining the low stock levels

4. For the ARV basket, availability was lowest for Niverapine 50mg (50%).

5. For the RMNCAH basket, availability was lowest for Amoxicillin(41%). Amoxicillin dispersable 125 mg is being phased out and NMS now supplies 250 mg

6. For the LAB basket, availability was lowest for blood (28%) and CD4 reagent (47%)
