FAST FACTS FROM THE 2016 LIBERIA MIS

The 2016 Liberia Malaria Indicator Survey (LMIS) provides population-based estimates on malaria indicators to inform strategic planning and program evaluation. The 2016 LMIS is the 3rd Malaria Indicator Survey conducted in Liberia.

MALARIA PREVALENCE



45% of children age 6-59 months tested positive for malaria by rapid diagnostic test.

Malaria prevalence ranges from a low of 12% in Greater Monrovia to a high of 69% in South Eastern B.

MALARIA PREVENTION



44% of children under 5 and40% of pregnant women age15-49 slept under an ITN the night before the survey.



22% of pregnant women age I 5-49 received 3+ doses of IPTp (and at least I during ANC) to prevent malaria in pregnancy.
