Cholera is an acute diarrhoeal disease that can kill within hours if left untreated.

Researchers have estimated that each year there are up to

4M cases
and up to
143K deaths

TREATMENT KITS

There are 3 kinds of treatment kits that each have supplies for 100 people: central, periphery and community

To create pop-up clinics where none exists
